- Fenestration to wall ratio is less than or equal to 40%
- Ratio of the gross skylight areas to gross ceiling area is less than or equal to 5%

Note: If any of these conditions are not met, the building must use one of the compliance paths outlined in MMAH Supplementary Standard SB-10, Division 3, Chapter 1, Article 1.1.2.1. In addition, permit applications for these buildings must submit the "Energy Efficiency Design Summary - Part 3 (Jan 1 to Dec 31, 2017)" form.

For projects that meet these conditions, all forms are to be completed and signed by the individual(s) who reviews and takes responsibility for the energy efficiency aspects of this project. All permit applications made after December 31, 2017 must instead use the corresponding EEDS form.
