INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To: Stephen O'Brien, City Clerk, City of Guelph

We have audited the Statement of Campaign Income and Expenses for the campaign period from January 2, 2014 to December 31, 2014 of **Cam Guthrie**, candidate. This financial statement has been prepared in accordance with the accounting procedures established by the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.

Candidate's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

Cam Guthrie is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of this financial statement in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, and for such internal control as the candidate determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on this financial statement based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statement is free of material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statement. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statement, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statement in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. An audit also includes the evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by Cam Guthrie, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statement.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the inherent nature of the transactions in an election campaign, the completeness of various categories of income and expenses is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of income and expenses was limited to the amounts recorded in the records of Cam Guthrie, candidate and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to income, expenses and surplus/deficit.

Qualified Opinion

In our opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which we might have determined to be necessary had we been able to satisfy ourselves concerning the completeness of the records referred to in the preceding paragraph, this financial statement presents fairly, in all material respects, the income and expenses for the campaign period from January 2, 2014 to December 31, 2014 and the determination of surplus or deficit and the disposition of surplus in accordance with the accounting treatment prescribed by the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.

Basis of Accounting and Restriction on Use

Without modifying our opinion, we draw attention to the Municipal Elections Act of 1996, which describes the basis of accounting. The financial statements are prepared to assist Cam Guthrie, candidate, to comply with the financial reporting provisions of the Act referred to above. As a result, the financial statement may not be suitable for another purpose. Our report is intended solely for Cam Guthrie, candidate, and the City of Guelph.
