Join us at the Guelph Community Pottery Centre at 50 Municipal St. The Pottery Centre consists of 10 electric pottery wheels, two kilns and all the essentials for creating pottery. Our Pottery technician, along with other talented potters, volunteers and staff, prepare a large assortment of glazes, finishes and kiln firings. Fee includes glazings, firings and your first bag of clay. One bay of clay is usually enough for the duration of a 10-week program. Additional clay may be purchased at \$30/bag, which includes glazes and firing.
