- Have enagaged in discussion with City Engineering- regarding water balance, groundwater, SWM design, thermal mitigation. Ongoing discussions will take place to resolve issues from City Staff Report.
- Will be meeting with Parks and working towards addressing their comments
- Working towards gaining baseline information, data loggers to get peak times over the summer for aquatic information. Will be able to satisfy City comments.

• Discussion of ponds that will be taken offline. Opportunity to make the improvements to Torrence Creek. SWM pond that will provide quality and quantity function and oulet to Torrence Creek.

Dan McCreery from Stantec provided further comments:

- A description and methodology that can be included in the report
- In favour of providing more discussion in the report
- Inclusion of detail around structure placement as well as erosion control

General Discussion:

- Fish habitat data to be included in the revision
- Chanel corridor can be expressed in more detail in the report- historical overlays, full review that could influence the future
- Intent is to construct in the next available season to allow some growth and establishment
- Little discussion around the existing water depths to provide a benchmark. Should include better presentation of this
- Be careful to not over design/static design
