	Ken VanderWal, Project Engineer with the City of Guelph, spoke to detailed design:
	The Environmental Assessment (EA) has been approved, but there is now a Part II Order request
	The abutments and cultural heritage landscape are the main concerns
	Abutments are undermined and the suggestion is to remove and reuse them in a sympathetic design
	Intention is to keep footprint and road similar to its current size
	Looking to make enhancements through wildlife crossings and landscaping

- Discussion around retaining wall funnel fencing for wildlife culvert
- Consultant spoke to the three alternatives
- Bridge construction will not be commencing until August still refining
- Discussion around increased flood plain and substrate materials for stabilization
- Discussion around GRCA comments update

# **Delegation: Laura Murr**

- Former member of RSAC and Green Plan Steering Committee
- Niska Road bisects an ecologically diverse area
- Viewscape will be greatly affected
- EA only addresses impacts directly adjacent to the road and does not consider the whole area or long term impacts
- Noted gaps in information
- Need to consider the protection of the east side of the river
- Heritage Impact Assessment not completed for the entire cultural heritage landscape which was supposed to be completed before design stage

### **Delegation: Hugh Whiteley**

- Reviewed RSAC mandate
- Reviewed the River Systems Management Plan
- Believes there is misinformation circulating about Niska Bridge
- Provided a recommendation:

Take the time needed to prepare an evidence based recommendation – form subcommittee to gather information and do necessary liaison

- Ken VanderWal spoke to traffic component of EA will not be rerouting traffic down this
  area

#### Moved by Nicola Lower and seconded by Kendall Flower,

THAT the River System Advisory Committee support the following in relation to the preliminary alternative design options on the east and west banks, under the bridge and the road:

- Consideration of abutment removal subject to the protection and enhancement of fish habitat including shoreline stabilization and water quality improvements, natural substrates along the banks beneath the bridge;
- Consideration for terrestrial habitat enhancement including wildlife crossings, invasive species management, opportunities for foraging and fauna movement within the landscape restoration plan.
- A SWM strategy that incorporates additional SWM water quality measures beyond incorporation of OGS;
- Minimization of encroachment into the adjacent natural areas from the road and bridge footprints; and,
- Preparation of a wildlife construction protocol, dewatering plan, sediment and erosion control plan and a phasing/staging plan;

THAT the River System Advisory Committee be provided an opportunity to collaborate with Heritage Guelph and review r the environmental addendum and supporting reports and provide further input into the advancement of the detailed design phase of the Niska Rd project.
