

## Notice of Study Completion

### Stormwater Management Master Plan Class Environmental Assessment

#### The Study

The City of Guelph has completed a City-wide Stormwater Management Master Plan. The Stormwater Management Master Plan is a long-term strategy that will help the City manage stormwater safely and effectively, while improving the health of the Speed and Eramosa Rivers and their tributaries.

The Stormwater Management Master Plan study has assessed existing infrastructure and the environment, determined stormwater infrastructure needs for future infill/intensification growth, and developed a preferred stormwater management strategy: a prioritized list of capital projects, programs and policies to address flood risk, water quality and quantity.

#### Master Plan Report

The Stormwater Management Master Plan Report, which documents the planning process and rationale for the preferred stormwater management strategy, will be placed on the public record for 30-calendar days. **This public review period will begin on February 16, 2012 and end on March 19, 2012.** Community members and interested parties are invited to review the Stormwater Management Master Plan Report and provide comments to the project team members listed below. #### The Process

The study has been conducted in accordance with the Master Planning process outlined in Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Municipal Engineers Association, October 2000 as amended in 2007) document, which is an approved process under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act. This Master Plan has addressed Phases 1 and 2 of this process, and has included public and review agency consultation, an evaluation of alternatives, and the development of a preferred stormwater management strategy.

The preferred stormwater management strategy consists of a prioritized list of capital projects, programs and policies. The Schedule A or A+ projects identified in the Master Plan are pre-approved and may proceed to implementation. Schedule B projects will require more detailed analysis and public consultation prior to implementation.
