	a) Organics Facility update on operations.				
7	From Monday 22nd June 2015 until Friday the 18 th September 2015 the plant has processed 4876.803 tonnes of Source Separated organics.				
	The facility has shipped out 1312.42 tonnes of finished compost in this time.				
	The amount of screening waste from the plastics bin leaving the facility in this time frame is as follows:				
	Screening waste- plastics bin- 70.39 tonnes				
	Screening waste plastics bin as a percentage of incoming source separated organics is 1.44%.				
	There have been two rejected loads in this time period. Contaminated with blue box material				
	Facility has been running taking waste from the City of Guelph and the Region of Waterloo in this 3 month timeframe.				
	b) Overview of odour complaints since 25 th June 2015 meeting				
	There have been 35 odour complaints on 25 days since the last plc meeting. The City confirmed odours on 9 of these days.				
	The City has recognised there have been odours emitted from the site and has worked with our partners to reduce the odour emissions.				
	The City apologised on behalf of the City and Wellington Organix for the odours that had been emitted in the summer months.				
	Ken Spira asked that there would be more open and transparent information dissemination between the City and residents and that there be more specific information on remedial actions undertaken.

	The total incoming material to the site in the time period 20 th June 2015 to the 18 th September 2015 was 39025.12 tonnes, the outbound material from the site was 32349.06 tonnes. Taken from Geoware on 23 rd September 2015.

	Waste Water bin The discussion was around that if the City thinks there has been a site issue when an odour complaint comes in, then it should be reported back to the resident. The City will look at providing more information					
	Ontario Fire Code as it relates to the SUBBOR building The City informed the Plc that the building had not been moth balled and that it was inspected annually as per regulations					
	Contact information for On call and Solid Waste Resources Site 49 letters had been delivered out on the 28 th July 2015 to houses on Watson, Stone, Glenholm and Cook Mill. Ken Spira asked if the City would deliver out letters to airport road, the City agreed to do					
	this. New signage will be done for the site when the new public drop off opens The City will look at the numbers placed on the website.					
8	Review Fugitive Odour emissions plan as it relates to Site activities The current document is very specific to the organics plant. A motion was made by the committee for the City to review the document. The City agreed to review it as it pertains to the whole site.					
	Use of Old organics building for Storage The City is currently not using this building for the storage of blue box recyclable materials.					
	PDO project update Construction is underway and it is expected the new PDO will open in November					
	Soil pile storage update Some of the soil will be used for the berm in the PDO project. For further information, the engineering dept. will need to be contacted.					
	Abatement letter dated 9 th July 2015 and Guelph Mercury Article dated 17 th Aug 2015 Article in the Mercury had upset some of the local residents, the City said some of the information had been taken out of context and there had been a delay between an interview given and the publishing of the article. The City had admitted there were odours and had emailed both the plc and council on the 24 th July to this point.
