	a) Organics Facility update on operations.			
	From Monday 22 nd July 2013 until Friday the 25 th October 2013 the plant has processed 4961.8 tonnes of Source Separated organics.			
	The facility has shipped out 936.4 tonnes of finished compost in this time.			
	The amount of screening waste leaving the facility in this time frame is as follows:			
	Screening waste- plastics bin- 91.55 tonnes			
7	Screening waste as a percentage of incoming source separated organics is 1.85%.			
	Facility has been running taking waste from the City of Guelph and the region of waterloo in this 3 month timeframe.			
	b) Overview of odour complaints since July 24 th meeting			
	There have been 2 odour complaints within the last 3 months since the last plc meeting. Both were investigated by the City and the MOE and were not attributed to the facility			
	Status of current amendments (PDO and negative air pressure):			
8	Negative air pressure- The MOE has given the City 9 months to collect some more data, this will be reviewed in February 2014.			

	PDO- The project is still ongoing, any significant updates will be provided to the committee.			
	Solid Waste Management Master Plan Update:			
9	Latest updates can be found on the City website			
	3 focus groups held last week at solid waste resources. 22-24 th October. Multi residential, commercial and institutional, residential. Opinions taken at meetings.			
	4 th meeting of steering committee will be in November, no date as yet.			
	There was a lot of discussion around information sharing between this committee and the solid waste master planning committee. It was noted that the City would try to ensure information is passed between the groups.			
	Other business			
10	Reduce vs. Diversion- there was discussion around the document that had been provided by the Ministry. Ken thought the primary focus should be on a reduction strategy rather than diversion.			
	Contract 13-134, installation of HVAC units at WRIC- Ken asked if odour minimisation had been taken into consideration. These units were to circulate air within the building. Nothing is exhausted.			
	Bin Packaging- The City was questioned about the packaging around the new carts. It was there to help movement/ transportation of the carts. Any plastics would be recycled.			
	Peel Energy recovery center- Ken was asking for information from the other committee members. It was directed to the Peel website for further information			
	Information sharing with the master plan committee- Had been covered in the discussion around the solid waste master plan update.
