7	<ul> <li>a) Organics Facility update on operations.</li> <li>From Monday 21<sup>st</sup> July 2014 until Friday the 14<sup>th</sup> November 2014 the plant has processed 6465.02 tonnes of Source Separated organics.</li> <li>The facility has shipped out 1004.99 tonnes of finished compost in this time.</li> <li>The amount of screening waste from the plastics bin leaving the facility in this time frame is as follows:</li> <li>Screening waste- plastics bin- 58.27 tonnes</li> <li>Screening waste plastics bin as a percentage of incoming source separated organics is 0.90%.</li> <li>Facility has been running taking waste from the City of Guelph and the Region of Waterloo in this 3 month timeframe.</li> <li>b) Overview of odour complaints since 24<sup>th</sup> July 2014 meeting</li> <li>There have been no odour complaints since the last plc meeting.</li> <li>The total incoming material to the site in the time period 18<sup>th</sup> July to the 14<sup>th</sup> November 2014 was 48447.26 tonnes, the outbound material from the site was 40225.91 tonnes. Taken from geoware on 19<sup>th</sup> November 2014.</li> </ul>
