2014 Tax Supported Operating Budget

Ms. Ann Pappert, Chief Administrative Officer, introduced the proposed 2014 Tax-supported Operating Budget. She advised that the proposed budget includes no service reductions, maintains the existing reserve fund balances and includes a three year operating forecast for information. She highlighted the Financial Strategy of a strong foundation, performance, position, open reporting and the next steps.

Councillor Burcher arrived at 6:18 p.m.

Mr. A. Horsman, Executive Director Finance & Enterprise/Chief Financial Officer, provided a brief history on past budgets and the progress made under the Financial Strategy. He highlighted the predictable formula/budget model and the 2015-2017 multi-year operating budget. He provided statistics related to total municipal burden as a percent of household income, municipal credit rating comparison, use of the tax rate stabilization reserve and the distribution of municipal tax dollars between the municipal and local boards and shared services. He reviewed the impacts affecting the 2014 operating budget and highlighted key 2014 corporate initiatives and the strategic investments (proposed expansion packages).

Clarification was provided with respect to the multi-year operating budget, boulevard maintenance and the process for recommending the strategic investments.
