# **Items for Discussion**

# 388 Arkell Road – Proposed Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-law Amendment Files: OP1705 and ZC1708 – Ward 6

Lindsay Sulatycki, Senior Development Planner provided an overview of the 388 Arkell Road proposed Official Plan Amendment and Zoning by-law amendment. She advised that the zoning by-law exemption requested is to change the zoning to the standard "Educational, Spiritual, and Other Services" (I.1) Zone. She explained that the Official Plan amendment is to include a site-specific policy to add a school as a permitted use within the existing Institutional and small scale office uses designation.

Pierre Chauvin, MHBC Planning provided an overview of the proposed development. He addressed the relationship between the development and the surrounding area and the need for the school.

Jennifer Passy, Upper Grand District School Board provided information regarding the need for a high school due to city growth and capacity needs. She explained the school board processes, timelines for development and plans for the property.

Shelly Jennings, a resident in the area raised concerns regarding traffic and noise. She inquired about public access to the property, development timing and the breakdown of students walking, driving and busing.
