Item 5

1 Quebec Street

Designation By-law (1983)-11115

Heritage permit application HP18-0007 proposing demolition of a rear, 2-storey addition and the extension of the southeast addition fronting Quebec Street.

- Stephen Robinson introduced Elena Zizza (owner) and Lloyd Grinham (architect)
- Provided historical background and reviewed designation bylaw
- Proposed addition would extend the existing 2-storey additions previously constructed in brick on the back of this building
- Lloyd Grinham spoke to the proposed design which is more contemporary in nature and is to be compatible with the original building

43 Arthur Street South

Designation By-law (2018)-20297

Heritage permit application HP18-0009 proposing signage to be installed on the north and south elevations of the Spring Mill Distillery building.

- Josh Kaufmann from Fusion Homes provided a presentation which included images of recent renovations and a signage masterplan which identifies signage locations
- Concerns around the amount and sizing of lettering on the heritage stone wall
- Discussions around alternate considerations for signage and design
- Josh Kaufman explained the reasoning behind the chosen location and signage identifies a sense of community and deliberate inclusion of "at the Metalworks" in the south elevation
