#### RE: KINGSTON CITY COUNCIL MEETING - NEW MOTION - MAY 20, 2014

I would confirm that Kingston City Council at its regular meeting held on May 20, 2014, approved the following resolution as amended, being New Motion 4:

Moved by Deputy Mayor Neill 4) Seconded by Councillor Hutchison Whereas the City of Toronto has enacted By-law #1177-2009 to prohibit all Corporate and Union donations in Toronto Municipal Elections; and Whereas other Ontario Municipalities are not granted the same powers to so adopt such rules of election finance under the Municipal Elections Act, 2006; Therefore Be It Resolved That the City of Kingston request that the Province of Ontario grant similar powers to all Ontario Municipalities so that future Councils have the power to enact similar restrictions, should they so choose; and That copies of this motion be sent to AMO, all Ontario Municipalities over 40,000 residents; and after the current election, to the Ontario Premier, Leaders of all parties, Minister of Municipal Affairs, and the Municipal Affairs Critics of all Parties.
