

Imagine a Day Without Water Artwork Submission Form

Purpose: To raise awareness about water conservation, efficiency and the importance of water, wastewater, stormwater, and source water services provided by the City of Guelph (“City”). The City invites students from FDK to Grade 12 who reside in Guelph to submit original artwork (“Art”). The City will select up to two (2) pieces of Art from each category based on imagination, creativity and understanding of the theme; “Imagine a Day without Water”. These selected pieces will be displayed by the City in public in any media (including social media) to promote water conservation, wastewater, stormwater, and source water protection.

Art Guidelines:

- One submission per student
- Original artwork and created by a single student only
- Be appropriate for all ages
- Maximum size is 8.5” x 11” and must be hand-drawn. Acceptable mediums include crayon, marker, pen, pencil, pencil crayon, paint, and pastels. Creativity is encouraged, however, please no digital media artwork, adhesives, stickers, glitter, or photo collage.
- Only high quality scans will be accepted (~5MB or more)

Instructions: Fill in the attached form and attach your artwork. NOTE you must fill in each field and check all boxes or your form will not be accepted. Youth under the age of 18 years will need the Parental Consent area filled in. Print off and sign the form. You may scan (5MB or more) and email your form and Art to waterservices@guelph.ca or print off and sign the form and personally deliver or send in the mail with your submission to City of Guelph, Water Services Department, 29 Waterworks Place, Guelph, ON, N1E 6P7, Compliance and Performance by October 12, 2021.

Please, follow these steps to participate:

- 1) Create your art piece
- 2) Fill in the attached form (NOTE you must fill in each field and check all boxes or your form will not be accepted) youth under the age of 18 years will need the Parental Consent area filled in.
- 3) Submit your artwork with your signed form by October 15th, 2021.
