Program Deliverables and Scope	The City of Guelph is looking to develop and build a new City Operations Campus to support the City's Transit, Fleet, Corporate Building Maintenance, Operations and Solid Waste Resource departments, over the next 25 plus years so that they may work efficiently and effectively and continue to satisfy service delivery requirements for a growing city. Building from the vision of the Guelph Innovation District Secondary Plan this new Operations Campus will protect, maintain, and enhance the valuable natural and cultural heritage resources surrounding the campus and feature sustainable buildings and infrastructure, contributing to the City's Strategic Plan. The scope for the overall project is to complete the required background technical studies; develop an Operations Campus Site Plan based on this work; and prepare an overall development Phasing Plan for the campus, including obtaining site plan approval for the campus site plan. 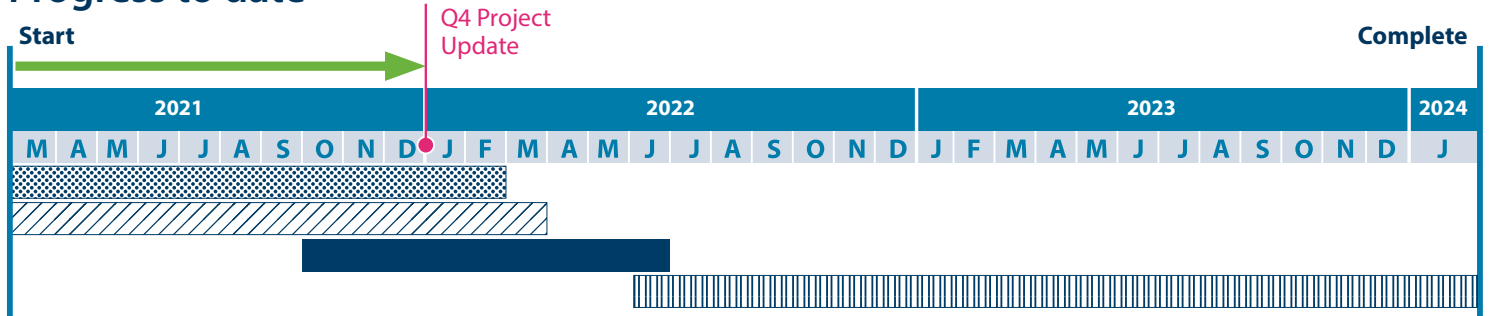
