Basketball half-court	4	Not added due to noise-related issues anticipated. Other elements would have to be minimized due to size of park.
Ice rink	3	A natural ice rink is located in the Eastview Community Park.
Off-leash dog run	3	Not added due to limited space. The Park size isn't big enough to consider an off-leash dog area.
Games table	1	Will consider at detailed design stage.
Butterfly garden	1	Not added due to limited space and budget. A rain garden is proposed.
