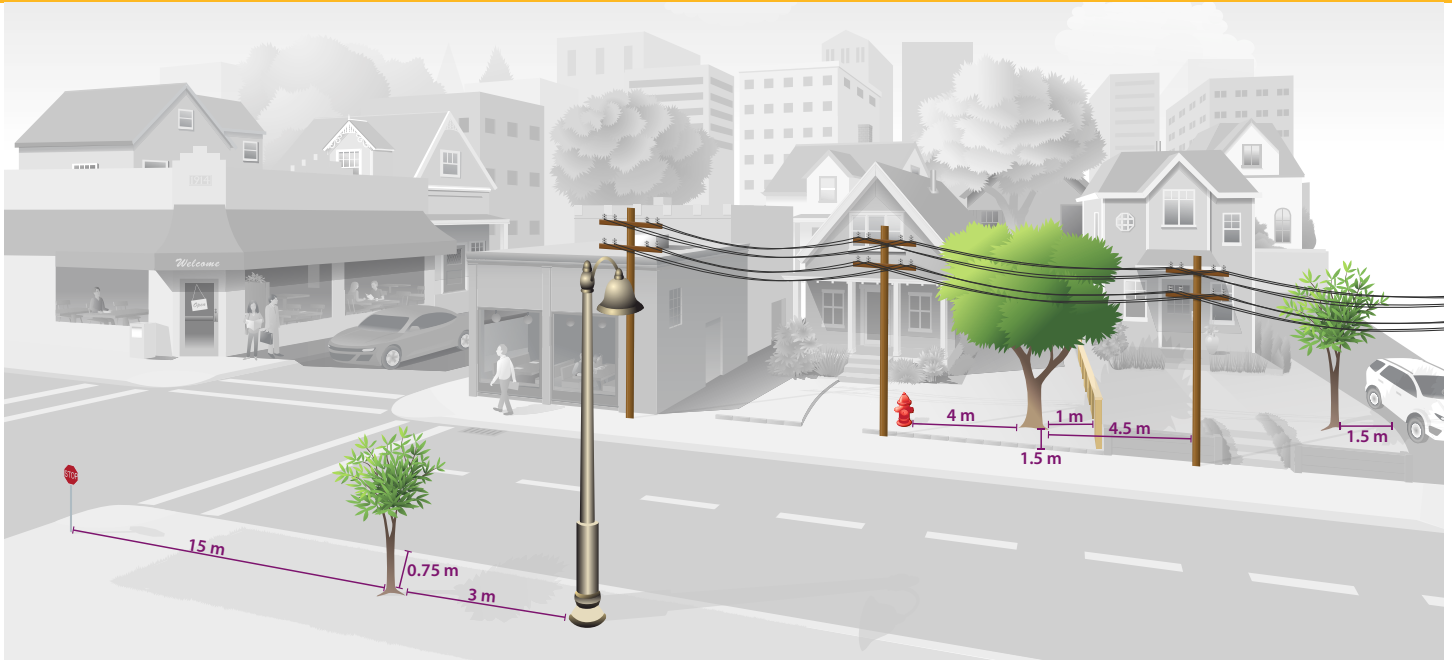


Tree planting location guidelines



Buildings and entrances	4 metres
Overhead utilities	4.5 metres, unless it's a species that stays 6 metres or shorter
Underground services	1.5 metres
Utility and telecommunications trenches	1.5 metres
Water hydrants	4 metres
Hydro transformer	3 metres from the side with a door, otherwise 1.5 metres
Light standards and utility poles	3 metres
Residential driveways	1.5 metres
Commercial driveways	3 metres
Stop signs and intersections	15 metres
Drainage swales	1.5 metres
Property lines	1 metre
Sidewalk edge	1.5 metres
Curb face	0.75 metres

If you're planting a tree, the City's Tree Technical Manual provides more information about offsets and how to plant and care for your new tree.

These are guidelines only.

For specific offsets from utilities, contact your utility provider.

You must have locates before you dig. It's the law.
