[Guelph's Official Plan](#) sets out the goals and policies we use to manage land use in our city—how we protect and enhance natural areas, which parts of the city have residential, commercial or industrial development, designing enjoyable neighborhoods with parks, transportation and other amenities. It's a legal document developed through a public process that is legislated by a various Provincial acts and policies including the Planning Act.

Master plans build on the goals and policies from the Official Plan to define long-term objectives for specific municipal programs and services. Master plans integrate existing and future land use and infrastructure planning with the principles of environmental assessment planning
