

# Water and Wastewater Education Program

## Grade 2

From source to tap and tap back to source—your students can learn about Guelph’s water and wastewater!

### Program overview

During our 40-minute classroom presentation, students will learn the importance of protecting and conserving water through engaging and interactive activities. Students will learn how we get our water in Guelph, where it comes from (groundwater!), how it makes its way to the tap, and what happens to it after it disappears down the drain.

Our presentations are designed to reflect the current curriculum as it relates to understanding earth and space systems for grade 2 students.

### Grade 2 presentation

Our grade 2 presentation engages students through games, teamwork and storytelling. Students will explore their personal connections to water. We will examine where our water comes from and what happens to it once it leaves our home. Students will learn about our role as a community and how our individual behaviour can help maintain a healthy environment – natural and built.
