





# Outside Water Use Conditions Report

Reporting period: July 31 to Aug 6

Issue date: Aug 7, 2024

## Background

The City of Guelph's Outside Water Use Program (OWUP) was created in 2002 to help reduce water demand during peak periods and to conserve and protect our groundwater during the summer months. Based on weather trends and local watershed conditions, the OWUP has three levels that affect residential outside water use – Level 0 Blue, Level 1 Yellow and Level 2 Red.

## Level Summary

- We are still in level 0 Blue. We had 17mm of rain last Thursday, which moved our monthly normals to 182% of normals. Yesterdays anticipated heavy rainfall, missed us and we only registered 1mm of rain.
- The upcoming forecast is showing a chance of rain nearly every day, but all low amounts of rain.
- Temperatures this past week were normal for this time of year. Temperatures are predicted to be normal for the next 2 weeks with a break in the high humidity.
- Average production amounts in the past week are trending slightly lower than the same as
  last year at this time and overall for the month of July production is trending lower than last
  year and lower than the 10 year average.
