Construction starts in August


Construction is expected to begin in August 2015 and be completed by November 2015. During the construction of the multi-use path, traffic on Woodlawn Road West will be reduced to one lane east or west bound direction only.

About the project

The City is constructing a multi-use path on Woodlawn Road on both the north and south side between the existing curb and property line from Silvercreek Parkway to Nicklin Road. The construction includes placement of a three metre wide asphalt path for active transportation use. (Pedestrians, cyclists and other self-powered forms of transportation)

The design and implementation of the Woodlawn Road Multi-use path is consistent with the approved Cycling Master Plan. The master plan is a ten year strategy to make cycling easier, safer and more accessible in Guelph by building a connected network of on- and off-road bike facilities throughout Guelph. It is part of the City of Guelph's efforts to support sustainable transportation, relieve traffic congestion, and make mobility accessible to all road users. Adding a multi-use path on Woodlawn Road West will also help to make Woodlawn Road West a route that accommodates all road users including public transit, cycling, pedestrians and vehicles.
