PETITION TO THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA

We, the undersigned, citizens of Canada draw the attention of the Government of Canada to the following;

THAT the WHO (World Health Organization)/International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC) has classified radiofrequency electromagnetic fields from cell towers, cell phones and Wifi as a Class 2B carcinogen – the same category that includes lead and DDT.

THAT the NRC Research Press have issued a report stating that cell towers should **NOT** be placed within 500 metres of residential properties, schools, hospitals, and daycares, but should be at least 1000 metres.

THEREFORE, we the undersigned citizens of Canada, call on the Government of Canada to:

- immediately revise Health Canada Safety Code 6 to take into account accumulative biological and health effects not just thermal effects of microwave radiation, with a strict stated limit for exposure. Revisions must implement and enforce stricter limits to all new and existing cell towers, wireless, base stations, antennas, transmitters;
- immediately enforce a moratorium on all new installations of cellular and wireless antennas, transmitters, base stations across the country until further unbiased non-industry funded scientific research has examined the short-term and long-term biological effects and health effects on humans from immediate and accumulative exposure to microwave radiation emitted from said devices;
- ban all new antennas, base stations, and transmitters to be installed within 500 meters of any residence, school, community centre, hospital or any place where people spend a good part of their day, and the frequency of pre-existing antennas must be immediately reduced to adhere to the precautionary principle as suggested in the biointitative report of 2012; ban installations of antennas on rooftops of apartment building or residential dwellings;
- consult all residents within a 1000 meter radius well in advance to any installation of cell towers, base stations, antennas and transmitters so they can be informed of the biological health effects and have a say on the long-term implications of these devices in their immediate neighborhood and quality of life. Local councils must be allowed to make their own decisions about the tower sites without being overruled; and
- call for immediate implementation of unbiased non-industry funded scientific research on the short-term and long-term biological and health effects of human exposure to microwave radiation, emf's and rf's, taking into account immediate and daily accumulative exposure, with full public disclosure of all findings
- adopt all recommendations from the House of Commons Standing Committee on Health's Report entitled "An Examination of the Potential Health Impacts of Radiofrequency Electromagnetic Radiation".

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PETITION TO THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA

We, the undersigned, citizens of Canada draw the attention of the Government of Canada to the following:

THAT studies have found that the microwaves that are emitted from cell towers are being linked to leukemia, infertility, cancer, Alzheimer's, autism and short term exposure are known to cause headaches, nausea, tinnitus, sleep disturbances, skin rashes, disorientation, vertigo, changes in vision, and can affect the cardiovascular and nervous system.

THAT residents within a 1000 meter radius should be consulted in advance to any installation of cell towers, base stations, antennas and transmitters so they can be informed of the biological health effects and have a say on the long-term implications of these devices in their immediate neighborhood and quality of life.

THEREFORE, we the undersigned citizens of Canada, call on Industry Canada to NOT approve the proposals for the Bell Cell Tower at the intersection of Grange and Starwood, and the Rogers wireless pole extension on Auden Road in Guelph and local councils must be allowed to make their own decisions about the tower sites without being overruled.

Radiation sickness is so prevalent in Germany that 175 doctors signed the Bramberger Appeal, calling the situation a "medical disaster." The slow burn process of RF/microwave exposure is manifested by cancer clusters commonly found in communities irradiated by cell tower transmitters. The head of the cancer registry in Berlin found one urban area with cellular antennas had a breast cancer rate seven times the national average.

In April 2007, The London Times reported a startling number of cancer clusters in mast neighborhoods.

Ninety-nine percent of the Swedish population is under duress of powerful third generation masts. People are plagued with sleep disorders, chronic fatigue, cognitive function difficulties, and serious blood problems. Recurrent headaches and migraines are a "substantial public health problem,"

In Spain parents secured a court order for the removal of 36 mobile phone transmitters installed on a building 50 meters from a primary school. In the 18 months since these masts went up three children aged 5-10 developed leukemia and a fourth had Hodgkins. India ordered the removal of 300 towers from residential areas due to the deleterious health effects.
