

Almost one third of all water used in the home is flushed down the toilet. The workplace is another high toilet use location.

Saving water and money is as easy as replacing your old toilets (6-litre or larger) with new high-efficiency WaterSense® certified models of 4.8 litres or less through the City of Guelph's Royal Flush Toilet Rebate Program.

Replace any toilets that use six (6) litres or more with approved low-flush models in your multi-family residence (apartment building, building, housing condominium or townhouse complex), or business, school, office or place of worship and receive a \$50 rebate from the City of Guelph for each toilet, by cheque or credited directly to your water account on your monthly Alectra Utilities (former Guelph Hydro) bill.

The City reserves the right to refuse a Rebate for any applicant, building or toilet that it determines is ineligible to participate in the program.

To qualify for a rebate:

- Multi-residential and Industrial, Commercial and Institutional properties are limited to one (1) WaterSense® certified toilet Rebate for each existing toilet being replaced per property and should contact Royal Flush Toilet Rebate Program at 519-822-1260 x 2633 to advise of the number of toilets being replaced and discuss site inspection requirements.
- Toilets being replaced must be 6-litre per flush or larger toilets and be replaced with WaterSense® certified dual flush or high efficiency toilet models that flush with 4.8-litres or less.
- There must be a valid Alectra Utilities (former Guelph Hydro) account associated with the building being retrofitted
- The building being retrofitted must be located within Guelph city limits
- The building being retrofitted be on the municipal water system
- The building being retrofitted must have been built before January 1, 2014
- You must submit the appropriate application and proof purchase within one (1) year of purchasing the toilet(s)

Terms and conditions

In consideration of receiving the rebate under this Royal Flush Toilet Rebate Program, the undersigned Applicant acknowledges and agrees:

1. THAT the Corporation of the City of Guelph (the "City") is not responsible for the selection, installation or operation of the toilet;
2. THAT the existing toilet being replaced is a 6-litre per flush or larger toilet and that the new toilet is a new, WaterSense® certified dual flush with 4.8 litres or less per flush;
3. If the applicant applied and received a rebate to change a 13-litre per flush toilet(s) or larger for a 6-litre per flush toilet(s) prior to January 1, 2018 then you may apply for a maximum of (1) certified toilet Rebate to replace the previously rebated 6-litre per flush toilet.
4. THAT the toilet must be installed in a building built prior to 2014, located in the geographic limits of the City and connected to the municipal water supply under an active Guelph Water account;
5. THAT the Applicant shall provide the City or its agents with reasonable and timely access to the toilet, that the City or its agents may inspect any residence or building participating in this Program in order to verify the installation of the toilet and eligibility of the same, if the City so requests, and that the City or its agents may access utility building account information for the purpose of monitoring water. The City reserves the right to withhold the Rebate based upon inspection results;
6. THAT the City does not guarantee or warrant the toilet or its installation, the performance, freedom from defects, quality of workmanship or suitability of the toilet or any installation thereof for any purpose, or the suitability of the premises for installation. Further, the Applicant acknowledges and agrees to assume any and all costs of the installation of any alterations necessary for the proper installation of the toilet;
7. To indemnify, save and hold harmless the City, and its agents, officials, officers, councilors and employees (collectively, the agents) against all liability, loss, costs, damages, and expenses, causes of action, actions, claims, demands, lawsuits and other proceedings, by whomever made, sustained, brought or prosecuted, including by third parties, involving bodily injury, death, and property damage, in any way based upon, occasioned by or attributable to the Applicant's participation in this Program;
8. To refund such Rebate to the City on request, if this application contains any material misstatement or misrepresentation on such Applicant's behalf, or if the Applicant breaches any of these terms or conditions;
9. Be either the applicable property owner or tenant; if the Applicant is a tenant, then such Applicant must submit documentation indicating that both the tenant and the property owner have knowledge of the Rebate Program and the application, and agree about to whom the Rebates should be paid; and
10. Submit a complete application form, with all applicable documentation.

Notice of Collection

The personal information on this form is collected pursuant to the Municipal Act, 2001 and in accordance with the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act. This information will be used for the purposes of administration of the Rainwater Harvesting System Rebate Programs.
